

UNEMPLOYED BECAUSE OF COVID-19?

Unemployment insurance
eligibility has expanded.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Workers experiencing layoffs due to:

- Loss of business during the outbreak
- Care for infected family members
- Orders to self-isolate
- Forced resignation due to COVID-19
- Forced resignation to decrease risk of Coronavirus exposure

HOW DO I FILE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS?

Be sure to have your Social Security Number, mailing address, phone number, dependents' info, and W-2.

HOW MUCH MONEY CAN I RECEIVE?

Benefits range from \$50 - \$430 per week for 26 weeks .

Federal legislation provides an additional \$600 and extends benefits period to 39 weeks.

I'M AN EMPLOYER. WHAT SHOULD I KNOW?

No increase in 2020 UI tax rate for employers due to COVID-19.

Employers may be able to apply to waive any benefits paid due to COVID-19. Additional information about this process is forthcoming.
